Section 1: Organizational Status

The Meat & Metal Guild is a Utah-based nonprofit corporation organized under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The organization operates exclusively for charitable, educational, and cultural purposes.

Section 2: Board Governance

The Corporation is governed by a Board of Directors responsible for fiduciary oversight, strategic direction, and policy approval.

- Board size: 3–9 directors
- Directors serve three-year terms
- Board meets at least annually, typically multiple times per year
- Quorum and voting requirements are defined in the bylaws

Section 3: Officers & Management

Officers are elected annually by the Board and include President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

The Board may appoint an Executive Director to manage day-to-day operations, execute Board policies, and represent the organization publicly.

Section 4: Financial Oversight & Accountability

The Board of Directors provides oversight of the organization's finances. The Treasurer oversees financial records and reports regularly to the Board. The organization maintains internal controls and governance policies to ensure responsible financial stewardship and compliance with applicable nonprofit regulations.

Section 5: Governing Documents

The organization operates under formal bylaws adopted by the Board of Directors. Copies of governing documents are available upon request.
